Course Description

This qualification reflects the role of workers in the residential setting who follow an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason. Work involves using discretion and judgement in relation to individual support as well as taking responsibility for own outputs. Workers have a range of factual, technical and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge of the concepts and practices required to provide person-centred support.

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements or pre-requisites for entry into this course.

Work Placement

To successfully complete this qualification students are required to attend 120 hours of industry work placement. This will be arranged at an IRT Academy partnered aged care centre.
