Course Description

This qualification reflects the role of support workers who complete specialised tasks and functions in the aged care sector. Workers will take responsibility for their own outputs within defined organisation guidelines and maintain quality service delivery through the development, facilitation and review of individualised service planning and delivery.

Workers may be required to demonstrate leadership and have limited responsibility for the organisation and the quantity and quality of outputs of others within limited parameters.

Course Delivery

This qualification is delivered using a range of learning and assessment strategies. Students will attend face to face and virtual classes and engage in a range of activities including educator led practical sessions, group discussion and assessments including role-plays and simulations with specialist guest speakers.

Work Placement

To successfully complete this qualification students are required to attend 120 hours of industry work placement. This will be arranged at an IRT or affiliated aged care centre.
