# WHAT ARE THE STUDY REQUIREMENTS?

For those studying in a classroom/virtual classroom environment

- 6-8 hours of home study plus classroom hours.
- pre-reading is essential before attending classes.
  - additional 120 hours of workplacement.

Self-directed study is 15-20 hours a week, plus workplacement.



#### **IS THIS COURSE FOR YOU?**

Like choosing any area of study the choice is a personal one for you to make. Aged Care is a rapidly expanding industry where demand for workers will increase as the Australian population increases. The knowledge and skills required by an Aged Care worker are increasingly being respected by the population as a whole.



# WHEN AND WHERE ARE THE COURSES HELD?

- 6-8 month period (self- directed) online, workplacement
- 6-8 month period (blended) 14 face to face/virtual classes with 2 practical assessments and workplacement
- For face to face classes, these may be scheduled in Wollongong, Milton, Sydney and other IRT locations in NSW and ACT.



#### IS THERE WORKPLACEMENT AND WHO ORGANISES IT?

Yes, 120 hours of workplacement is required in an aged care centre. IRT Academy will assist in organising work placement but can't guarantee work placement in areas where IRT does not have an

aged care centre.
