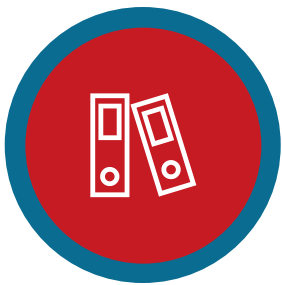

WHAT ARE THE STUDY REQUIREMENTS?

Students are required to complete 4 online units and related assessments. Course is a blended delivery, requiring students to have access to a computer with internet connectivity. Each module takes about 5-8 hours to complete. Workplace assessment time is additional.



IS THIS COURSE FOR YOU?

This course is for people who want to learn the skills and knowledge required to provide entry level support for basic client care required within the aged care and disability support sectors. The support provided in client care will be predominantly non-direct, with some basic direct client care.



WHEN AND WHERE ARE THE COURSES HELD?

This course is delivered via a blend of interactive online learning modules, simulation activities, as well as online and workplace assessments. Course is delivered twice a year - April and June intake.



IS THERE WORKPLACEMENT?

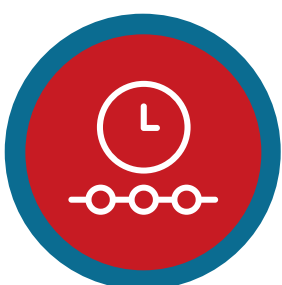
No formal workplacement hours are required, but there is workplace assessment. This is on-the-job observation completed by an accredited IRT Academy trainer and generally takes place at the person's place of work.



HOW WILL YOU BE ASSESSED?

You will be assessed a number of ways. These methods may include:

- Virtual classroom sessions
- Online-quiz
- Practical observations in the workplace
- Self-directed activities
- Workplace practice
