#### 2 Policy details

IRT Academy will:

- Assess a student's language, literacy and numeracy skills prior to their enrolment to ensure they have adequate skills to complete the training;
- Assessment will be facilitated by the Trainer/Assessor using an online assessment tool provided by LLN Robot or other approved assessment tool.
- For short courses, the assessment will be based on the student's ability to complete the RTO enrolment documentation and interaction with the learner (as appropriate).
- Support students during their study with training and assessment materials and strategies that are easily understood and suitable to the level of the workplace skills being delivered;
- Provide clear information to students about the detail of the language, literacy and numeracy assistance available;
- Refer students to external language, literacy and numeracy support services that are beyond the support available within IRT Academy resources and where this level of support is assessed as necessary.
- Negotiate an extension of time to complete training programs if necessary.

#### **In Practice Example:**

An individual enrolling into an IRT Academy Certificate III in Individual Support completes the LLN Robot Assessment Tool online. The results are reviewed by the Trainer/Assessor for the course and the results indicate that the individual has the appropriate level of LLN capabilities to meet the course requirements.



## **3** Roles and responsibilities

Role	Responsibility
Policy Owner – Group Head IRT Academy	Ensuring the currency and appropriateness of the policy to meet regulatory and legislative requirements.
Policy Monitor – RTO Manager	Ensure day to day implementation and compliance with policy.
Implementation – Learning Solutions Team Trainer/Assessor	Implement policy procedure requirements as per IRT Academy Procedure Manual.
