Course Description

CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing) targets jobs in residential or home care settings as aged care workers. In these jobs person-centred support is provided to older people to meet their individual needs.

Your training experience includes a blend of virtual classes, online learning, self-directed learning and group practical sessions as well as work placement. The duration is 20 weeks in total; 15 weeks based in the Philippines (supported by a Groworx Philippines OPC employed Tutor) at a Groworx Philippines OPC location including; a training room and simulation learning space.

On arrival in Australia you will complete five weeks of further training at IRT Academy; Wollongong Australia and work placement at an IRT Aged Care Centre.

Assessments includes both theory and practice with the theoretical part being completed in the Philippines. The practical assessments will be conducted in Australia and includes observations in a fully equipped simulated environment, role-plays, and workplace based observations.

You are required to successfully complete all training, work placement and assessment activities to achieve certification.
