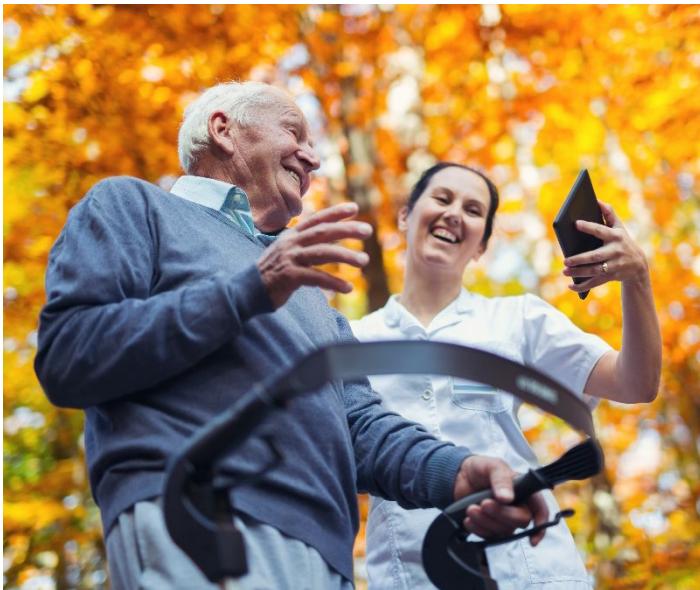

## Course Description
